How Ageing Affects Your Cat's Biology and Diet

As cats move past about 7–8 years, their bodies gradually lose muscle more easily, joints can become painful, and organs like kidneys and heart work harder than they used to, even if they still look “young” from the outside.

Many adult cats also develop dental wear, loose or missing teeth, and a weaker sense of smell, which quietly reduces how much they eat if food is hard, dry, or not aromatic enough.

In warm Indian homes where adult indoor cats already tend to drink too little, these changes together mean food must do more work: supply enough animal protein and calories, be easy to chew and digest, and carry a lot of moisture to support kidneys and the urinary tract.

What is the Best Adult Cat Wet Food

The best kind of adult cat wet diet still centres on high-quality animal protein (chicken, fish, organ meats) because adult cats need protein to maintain lean muscle, immune function, and organ health, even when their calorie needs fall slightly with lower activity.

How to Change Your Adult Cat's Food Safely

When changing an adult cat's food—especially to a richer, high-meat wet option—aim for at least 10–14 days of gradual transition, slowly increasing the share of the new wet food while keeping treats and other variables constant so the gut microbiome can adapt without shock.

During and after this change, watch body weight, appetite, stool consistency, ease of chewing, hydration signs (urine clumps, water intake), and overall energy; steady weight, comfortably formed stools, and more eager eating are good signs that the new senior-friendly routine is working.
